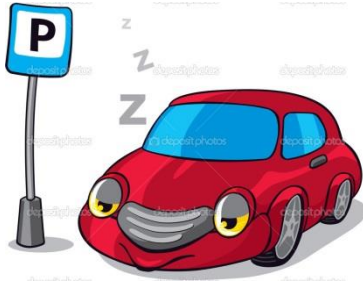


# Nóta tabhacht do thuismitheoirí Gaelscoil an Ghoirt Álainn.



1. **Ar maidin- Set down amháin atá ann díreach taobh amuigh de gheataí na scoile. – stad – cabhraigh le do pháiste – imigh.**

**Ná fág do charr san áit seo ar feadh tréimhse ró fhada mar chuireann sé isteach go mór ar trácht na háite agus na scoile.**

2. **Ná stop riamh i lár an bóthar taobh amuigh den scoil.**

3. **NB. Ná dean iarracht do charr a chasadh taobh amuigh den scoil– ag aon am.**

4. **Níl cead ag thuismitheoirí tiomaint isteach sa charrchlós gan cead. Tá cead speisialta ag dhá clann sa scoil. Má tá ceist agat maidir le seo is féidir labhairt le Deaglán**

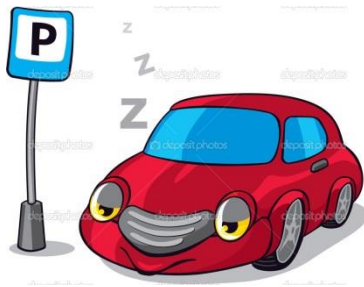
5. **Iarraimid ar thuismitheoirí gan siúl isteach i gclós na scoile via an carrchlós ar maidin nó ag am dul abhaile.**

## Important note for the parents of Children attending Gaelscoil an Ghoirt Álainn.

1. Morning time- Set down **only** immediately outside the school gates in the mornings.

Please **-Stop** your car. - **Help your child** safely out of the car & **leave**. All children should be able to walk unaccompanied from this area/from the entrance gate of the school, to the school yard.

Do not park your car immediately outside the school gates (either side of the road) for an extended period of time as it can create difficulties for other road users and for school traffic.

2. **Never** stop your car in the middle of the road to allow your child leave. This not only disrupts traffic but it's also very dangerous.
3. Please do not turn your car outside of the school gates at any time during the school day as children are often around this area and we want to ensure that our children are safe at all times. The practice of turning vehicles outside the school is very dangerous.
4. Parents are not to drive into the staff car park – (Unless they need to do so and have already made arrangements with school).
5. We ask parents not to walk into or out from the school via the gates at the staff car park as the barrier and the possibility of cars moving in this area creates a greater risk for parents & students.

These rules apply to everyone regardless of weather conditions. We strongly **recommend that children bring appropriate rain gear** to school with them (ie. rain coat and leggings) and together we will keep our school as a safe place for all.
